PROGRAM FEES OVERVIEW: Travel

- Travel Club Fees Cover:
 - o Practices, Goaltender Development, games, league registrations, tournament registrations
 - League Playoff Entrance Fees: CBHL, AHF/AGHF, Affiliate/State, USAH Nationals (where applicable)
 - o Other fees associated with club administration and programming
 - Expenses such as travel and lodging for non-parent head coach, and other miscellaneous expenses that pertain to the team/club itself
- Uniform, apparel, transportation and lodging are separate and not included in travel club fees.
- Payment information:
 - o TCE utilizes TeamSnap for registrations
 - o A 20% deposit is due at time of registration to secure a roster spot
 - o TCE provides a standard payment plan for five installment payments at no extra fee
 - Pricing is exclusive of payment processing fees
 - These fees are collected by the credit card processor and do not go to TCE
 - Processing feed can vary depending on if payment is made via credit card or ACH
 - Please note we do not accept cash or payment by check
- TeamSnap offers Regsaver, optional insurance to cover costs of your registration should you child be unable to participate due to sickness or injury
 - o Option is available at checkout
 - o Program is completely voluntary and not administered by TCE
